SNOW ROUTES

Limited bus transportation – When transportation limitations are in effect, for safety reasons there will not be bus or van service on side roads without easy turn arounds.

After snow storms please assume pick up point will be changed to alternate location:

| <u>Stops on</u> | <u>Stop moves to</u> | <u>Duration</u> |
|----------------------------------|--------------------------------------|-----------------------------|
| Dempsey Road | pick up at Highway 112 | road and turn around sanded |
| Lower Camp Hayden Road | pick up at Camp Hayden & Durrwachter | road and turn around sanded |
| Hwy 112 west of W. Lyre River Rd | Hwy 112 at W. Lyre River Road | road and turn around sanded |
| Dan Kelly/Eden Valley | Place Rd at Ranger Road | road plowed and sanded |

EMERGENCY SCHOOL CLOSURE INFORMATION

Situations occasionally arise which may require school schedule delays, closures, or changes in transportation. Each family should have a plan covering actions to take in various emergency situations (i.e., inclement weather, natural disaster, fire, etc.) and assure that current emergency information such as names, phone numbers and emergency contact person is on file at school. Parents and children should be prepared in advance for certain situations including: becoming familiar with the alternate bus pick-up/drop-off points on limited transportation schedule; what to do if a bus does not arrive due to road conditions, accident or breakdown; who to call or where to go for help; interim care for your child during unforeseen school closures and early releases.

Listen at 6:00 a.m. to radio stations KONP 1450 AM or KONP 101.7 FM, or to KOMO TV 4, KING TV 5 or KIRO TV 7 if you feel weather conditions may cause delays or closure of schools. Announcements are for one day only. However, parents should use their own discretion in determining whether to send their child(ren) to school if they feel conditions in their particular area are not safe. **For a recorded message on most recent school delays or closures, call the district's information line at 928-3311, option 4.**

Possible emergency messages underlined and what they mean:

Schools closed – All schools will be closed for one day only. All meetings, field trips, after school activities, etc. will be canceled for the day unless otherwise announced.

Limited bus transportation – When transportation limitations are in effect, for safety reasons there will not be bus or van service on side roads without easy turn arounds.

County road restrictions – In some situations, one or more county roads may be closed by order of the county engineer due to thawing conditions. In this case announcements will be made after notification by county officials.

One or two hour delay – Bus schedules and schools will begin one or two hours late. Students will be dismissed at the regular time unless there is a specific announcement regarding early dismissal. Also, listen for information regarding morning and afternoon kindergarten/pre-school sessions and other special programs.

Schools open, no transportation – Be prepared to provide transportation if announcement is made.
